Take Home Point:

Jesus is God's Son.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy learned that Jesus was born in a barn.
- *Bible:* We heard about the birth of Baby Jesus and acted it out.
- *Snack:* We ate animal crackers and made the noises of the animals in the stable.
- *Craft:* We made stick puppets so we could tell others about the birth of God's Son.
- *Game:* We played *What's in the Stable?*
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Farmer in the Dell*. "Jesus is God's Son, Jesus is God's Son, God sent him to save us all. Jesus is God's Son."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Luke 2:1-20

LEARN BY DOING:

Two-year old children have trouble with the concept of Jesus being God's Son. Point out different sons to your child, using males of all ages—young and old. When you tell your child that someone is a man's son, say, "Just like Jesus is God's Son."

TALK ABOUT IT:

- God promised to send his Son Jesus.
- Baby Jesus was born on Christmas day.
- Jesus is a special gift to us.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult says it.

Dear God,
We love you.
Thank you for sending
Your Son Jesus.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
Amen.
