Take Home Point:

God sent his Son Jesus.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Bubba learns that Jesus was God's special gift.
- *Bible:* We learned about Mary and Joseph and the Baby Jesus' birthday.
- *Snack:* We ate trail mix, just like Mary and Joseph might have.
- *Craft:* We made our own Baby Jesus and put him in a manger.
- *Game:* We played a game called *What's in the Stable?*
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Farmer in the Dell*: "Jesus is God's Son, Jesus is God's Son. God sent him to save us all. Jesus is God's Son."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Matthew 1:20-23; Luke 1:28-33

LEARN BY DOING:

God kept his promise that he would send his Son Jesus to save us. When you explain this to your child, teach him/her what promises are. Keeping promises told to a two year old is very important. It helps a child have confidence and security when promises are fulfilled. Therefore, when you keep a promise, mention it to your child, even in small things, such as: "Here is the cookie I promised you." Use these promise moments to remind your child that God kept his promise and sent Jesus into the world as his greatest gift for us.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- God promised to send his Son Jesus.
- Jesus is a gift for everyone.
- Jesus was a baby born on Christmas day.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult says it.

Dear God,
We love you.
You sent us your Son,
Baby Jesus.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
Amen.
