Take Home Point:

Pray to God our Father.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy talks to her Father in heaven.
- *Bible:* We acted out a simplified version of the *Our Father* prayer.
- *Snack:* We ate a snack that reminded us of hands folded in prayer.
- *Craft:* We made a craft of things about which we could pray to God our Father.
- *Game:* We played the *Hand Game*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Frere Jacques*: "God our Father. God our Father. We can pray. We can pray. Pray to God our Father. Pray to God our Father. We can pray. We can pray."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Matthew 6:9-13

LEARN BY DOING:

Make sure your little ones see you praying. They are real imitators and will be proud to do something that parents are doing. Be sure to help them with their own prayers also.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Jesus teaches us to pray to his Father.
- Praying to God our Father is talking to him.
- Our Father, God, hears our prayers.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult says it.
