This Week's Lesson:

Jesus Chooses a Tax Collector

Take Home Point:

Jesus said, "Follow me."

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy finds out that Matthew the tax collector was collecting taxes unfairly.
- *Bible:* We acted out Jesus telling Matthew the tax collector to follow him.
- *Snack:* We ate crackers that reminded us of coins.
- *Craft:* We made shoes to remind us and a friend to follow Jesus.
- *Game:* We played *Follow the Leader*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of: *Mary Had a Little Lamb*: "Jesus said come follow me, follow me, follow me. Jesus said come follow me, and help me show God's love."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Matthew 9:9-13

LEARN BY DOING:

Children learn their attitude about money from their parents. Let your child know that money is not the most important thing—Jesus is.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Matthew thought money was the most important thing.
- Matthew received Jesus' love.
- Matthew learned that God was the most important thing in life.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult says it.
