This Week's Lesson:

Jesus Calms the Storm

Take Home Point:

Ask Jesus for help.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Bubba gets scared and learns to ask Jesus for help.
- *Bible:* We acted out Jesus calming the storm, just like in the Bible.
- *Snack:* We ate pudding and topping that reminded us of the dark storm leaving.
- *Craft:* We made a door hanger for our room and one to give to a friend.
- *Game:* We played a game called *Ask Jesus for Help*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Farmer in the Dell*: "Jesus calmed the storm. Jesus calmed the storm. Jesus helps us all the time. Jesus calmed the storm."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Matthew 8:23-27

LEARN BY DOING:

Children are usually afraid of noisy storms. Get your child in the habit of praying to Jesus for help when child is afraid of something. Hold your child close as you explain this and pray with your child.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Jesus calmed the storm and the fears of the disciples.
- Jesus helped the disciples when they were afraid.
- God promises to hear our prayers when we need help.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult says it.

Dear God,
We love you.
You will help us
When we ask.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name,
Amen.
