DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Puppet: Bubba learned that God helps him be brave.
- Bible: We learned about and acted out how God was with David when he fought the giant.
- Snack: We ate a pretend slingshot and rocks.
- Craft: We made a shield.
- Game: We played a learning game called *God Helps You Be Brave* and a movement game called *Rock the Giant*.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about David praying to God for bravery against Goliath from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand.

(1 Samuel 17:1-50)

LEARN BY DOING:

When your child is afraid, talk about his/her fear. Pray together that God will help them and take care of them and help them not be afraid. Teach them that because of that, God helps them not be afraid.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- God can use them when they are brave.
- They can feel secure because God watches over them.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,

You are with us.

We love you.

Help me be brave.

Thank you, thank you, thank you.

In Jesus' name.

Amen.
