DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Puppet: Bubba loves a parade.
- Bible: We learned about and acted out how Joshua listened to God to get into the city of Jericho.
- Snack: We ate little trumpets.
- Craft: We made praise tubes.
- Game: We played a learning game called *Am I Listening?* and a movement game called *What Did You Say?*
- Singing: To the tune of *Row, Row, Row Your Boat*: Praise, praise, praise our God. Praise God every day. I will praise him. I will praise him. Praise God every day.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about Joshua listening to God and marching around the city of Jericho from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (Joshua 6:1-21)

LEARN BY DOING:

Purchase worship songs and play them in the car or at home. Remind your child that we can praise God like Joshua did.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- The people obeyed God and he knocked down the walls of Jericho.
- Joshua and his people praised God.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult
