## DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Puppet: Judy learns about trust.
- Bible: We learned about and acted out how Elijah trusted God to start his sacrifice on fire.
- Snack: We ate a snack that looked like an altar on fire.
- Craft: We made an altar with fire.
- Game: We played a learning game called *Would You Trust Me?* and a movement game called *Trust What I Say*.
- Singing: To the tune of *Mary Had a Little Lamb*: Trust God to take care of you, Care of you, Care of you. Trust God to take care of you. He loves you very much.

## FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about Elijah trusting God to burn the sacrifice from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (1 Kings 18)

## LEARN BY DOING:

Your child needs to learn that to trust someone means to believe what they say. When you keep your word with your child, reinforce it. Explain to your child that they can trust you and believe what you say. Then immediately point out that we can trust God and believe what he says. God will always be with us and love us.

## POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- Trust means to believe what someone says.
- Elijah trusted God.
- We can trust God.

**ECHO PRAYER:** Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,  
You are with us.  
We love you.  
We trust you.  
Thank you, thank you, thank you.  
In Jesus' name.  
Amen.
