**Take Home Point:**

Trust God.

## DRIVE TIME HOME

**PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.**

- Puppet: Bubba learns about trust.
- Bible: We learned about and acted out the three ways Elijah trusted God.
- Snack: We ate bread like Elijah.
- Craft: We made a picture of the never-ending jar of flour and jug of oil God promised the woman.
- Game: We played a learning game called *Would You Trust Me?* and a movement game called *Trust God*.
- Singing: To the tune of *Mary Had a Little Lamb*: Trust God to take care of you, Care of you, Care of you. Trust God to take care of you. He loves you very much.

## **FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse**

Read about Elijah trusting God to take care of him from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (1 Kings 17)

## **LEARN BY DOING:**

Help your child understand the concept of trust as you describe how you will help take care of what your child needs. Point this out as you provide food, hugs or other needs. Remind them that you can trust God to take care of you, too.

## **POINTS TO REMEMBER:**

- If you believe what someone says, you trust them.
- Elijah trusted and believed God.
- God took care of Elijah.

**ECHO PRAYER:** Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,

You are with us.

We love you.

We trust you.

Thank you, thank you, thank you.

In Jesus' name.

Amen.
