Joshua Crossing the Jordan

Take Home Point:

God is always with me.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Puppet: Bubba learns that God is always with him.
- Bible: We learned about and acted out how Joshua led the people across the Jordan River.
- Snack: We ate pretend rocks.
- Craft: We made a neck string that reminds us of the 12 rocks God told the people to take from the river to always remind them of the miracle of the parting of the Jordan River.
- Game: We played a learning game called *Is God With Me Now?* and a movement game called *Twelve Rocks*.
- Singing: To the tune of *The Farmer in the Dell*: For God is with me now. For God is with me now. No need to be afraid. For God is with me now.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about Joshua leading the people safely across the Jordan River from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (Joshua 3:14 – 4:9)

LEARN BY DOING:

Place a rock on the dinner table. After the meal, talk about how God's people used rocks to remind them that God is always with us. He showed that by helping them miraculously cross the Jordan River.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- Joshua trusted God when he crossed the Jordan.
- God is always with me.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult
