## DRIVE TIME HOME

**PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.**

- Puppet: Bubba learns about praying to God.
- Bible: We learned about and acted out how Daniel kept praying, even when the king told him to stop.
- Snack: We ate pretend lion claws.
- Craft: We made a lion cup puppet.
- Game: We played a learning game called *Can We Pray?* and a movement game called *When Can You Pray?*
- Singing: To the tune of *Farmer in the Dell*: We can pray to God. We can pray to God. Ev'ry one can pray to him. We can pray to God.

## **FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse**

Read from a children's picture Bible about Daniel following God, even when the king made a rule against praying, or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (Daniel 6:1-18) Be aware that the story will continue next week with the rescue of Daniel.

## **LEARN BY DOING:**

Teach your children they can pray anytime. When they hear an ambulance it is a reminder to pray. When they hear of someone who is sick, it is a reminder to pray. When they think of the gifts God gave them, like food and family, it is a reminder to pray.

## **POINTS TO REMEMBER:**

- Daniel prayed to God even when ordered to stop.
- Daniel was thrown in the lions' den, but still prayed to God.
- We can pray to God anytime, anywhere.

**ECHO PRAYER:** Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,  
You are with us.  
We love you.  
We will pray to you.  
Thank you, thank you, thank you.  
In Jesus' name.  
Amen.
