## God Talk At Home

**This Week's Kingdom Quest Lesson:**

Safe on an Island

**Take Home Point:**

Follow God and expect him to do amazing things.

### Drive Time Home

Tickler Question: What was the most *amazing* thing you heard in Kingdom Quest today?

### God Time at Home

*Select questions and adapt for your family.*

**FOR STARTERS:** Ask family members what amazing place they would like to travel someday. Why? Then say, "God takes each one of us on an amazing journey through our lives. Wherever he takes us we should expect that he will do amazing things."

**READ THE BIBLE:** Acts 28:1-10, Mark 16:15-19

**KEY VERSES:** Mark 16:15, 17, "Go into the world and preach the good news to all creation...and these signs will accompany those who believe..." (*amazing things*).

**TALK ABOUT IT:** What amazing things happened to Paul when he was shipwrecked on the island of Malta? (*Acts 28:3-8. A snake bit him while he was adding wood to the fire. However, the poisonous bite had no affect on him. He healed sick people on the island.*) From Mark 16:15-20, what kind of miraculous signs did Jesus say would accompany believers who told the Good News of Jesus? (*Mark 17-18. Believers could use the power and authority of Jesus' name to force demons out of people. They could speak new languages. They could pick up snakes and drink deadly poison and it would not hurt them. They could place their hands on the sick and cure them.*) Why do you think God did amazing things through Paul and Jesus' disciples as they witnessed about Jesus? (*To show the people that God was with his followers. To increase the faith of believers.*) Do you think God still does amazing things today like he did in Paul's day? What are some amazing things that might happen? (*God answers our prayers for healing; people we share the Good News with, receive it and become friends with God; people who are angry or mean might change when they receive love and understanding; people notice something different in your life because you follow God; etc.*)

**PRAYER POWER:** Thank God that the most amazing thing he did for us was to send Jesus to take the punishment for our sins. Thank him for how he continually works in our lives and still does amazing things for us. Ask for eyes to see God's wonders and faith to trust him as we follow him and tell others about the Good News of Jesus. Praise God for his promises and especially that all believers will be with him someday in that amazing place called heaven.
