This Week's Lesson:

Solomon's wisdom is God's wisdom

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): God is our King.

(Kids Say): Use your mind to serve the King.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Made a happy/sad puppet to demonstrate which activities we do that make God happy or sad.
- Played a beanbag game to help practice the take home point.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KIDS CHURCH.

- Learned the story of King Solomon's wisdom from "The Traveler."
- Played a memory game.
- Made a crown as a way to remember to use our minds to serve the King.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

God gives King Solomon wisdom from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from 1 Kings 3:16-28 & 10:1-3.

JESUS LINK:

Because of Jesus, God forgives us when we make wrong choices.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What is the best gift you ever received? Why?
- Solomon asked for the gift of wisdom. What does wisdom mean?
- How can we be wise and use our minds to serve God?

PRAYER POWER:

Ask God to help you be wise and make wise choices.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Make a chart with the words "I was wise" on top. Each time your child makes a wise choice, put a smiley face sticker or other happy sticker on the chart. When your child makes poor choices, remind him that the choice was not wise. Even when we sin or make poor choices, God loves us and forgives us because of Jesus.
