DRIVE TIME HOME

**PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.**

- Heard a creative storytelling presentation about King Jehoshaphat.
- Made and ate a "blue-ribbon snack"
- Made tambourines to remind us that God is our King – God will help us win.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

God wins a battle for King Jehoshaphat from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from 2 Chronicles 20:1-29.

JESUS LINK:

We can feel like winners, no matter what, when Jesus is in our hearts.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did King Jehoshaphat and the Israelites look for God's help?
- What scares you?
- God wants to help you with your problems. What can you do to get his help?

PRAYER POWER:

Pray to God and tell him your problems. Ask God to help you with your problems.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Have each family member draw a picture of a problem he is facing. For a young child, those problems might include nightmares, fear of large dogs, or getting into fights with brothers and sisters. Fold the pictures in half and put them in a Bible, as a reminder to give your problems to God.
