This Week's Lesson:

Daniel and the Lions' Den

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): God is powerful.

(Kids Say): God tames our fears.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Watched a video about Daniel and the lions' den.
- A balloon activity, in which we gave our fears to God.
- Made a lion snack.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Participated in a drama telling the story of Daniel and the lions' den.
- Made and ate an edible "lion's face."
- Made lion's face puppets in the craft zone.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Daniel and the Lions' Den, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Daniel 6:1-28.

JESUS LINK:

Because of Jesus, God's power is for us, too.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Tell me what happened in the story of Daniel and the lions' den.
- What scares you?
- What can we do when you are scared? How can God help?

PRAYER POWER:

Write "Jesus" on a large paper sack. Help your child wad up newspaper to make several newspaper balls. Throw the balls in the bag one at a time while naming fears. Explain that you are giving your fears to Jesus. Say a prayer asking Jesus to use his power to take away your fears.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Make a lion puppet. Draw a face on a paper lunch bag. Glue pieces of yarn around the face to make a mane. Have your child name several fears and make the lion roar. Remind your child that God is more powerful than all our fears.
