Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): God is powerful.

(Kids Say): Trust God's power. Cool!

DRIVE TIME HOME

**PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN

- An activity with a blow dryer fire during large group time.
- Took a trust walk as a reminder to follow God.
- Ate "fire sticks" for snack.

DRIVE TIME HOME

**PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.**

- Participated in an interactive drama about the three Men and the Fiery Furnace
- Made cards in the Craft Zone that remind us to "Trust God's Power"
- Built a furnace out of blocks in the Play Zone.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

The Three Men and the Fiery Furnace, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Daniel 3.

JESUS LINK:

We have Jesus' power with us always.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did God show the men in the fiery furnace he was powerful?
- What problems do you have?
- Who can help you with your problems? Why?

PRAYER POWER:

Think of some times God has used his power to help your child or family. Say a prayer together thanking God for his powerful help.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Make a promise to do a fun family activity each week. Ideas include a family game night, going out for pizza, inviting friends over for dinner, or visiting a local attraction. Your child must trust you to keep your promise. Remind your child that just as he knows to trust you, we know we can trust God's power.
