Take Home Point:

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Participated in the story, "Elijah Hears God's Voice."
- Made "bread and butter Bibles."
- Listened to a music tape and wrote what God was telling us.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Heard a story about Elijah hearing God's voice from "The Traveler."
- Acted out the story of Elijah in the Drama Zone.
- Played the telephone game, using today's take home point.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Elijah Hears God's Voice, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from 1 Kings 19:9-18.

JESUS LINK:

God's Word tells us about the Good News of Jesus.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Why was Elijah sad? What did God tell Elijah?
- What does God tell us in the Bible?
- When can we listen to God's word?

PRAYER POWER:

Before reading a Bible story, ask God to help you be good listeners to hear what he is telling you through the story.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Start a Bible journal. After you read a Bible story, have your child draw a picture of what God was saying. Keep the pictures in a binder to make your child's own Bible book.
