Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): God is our King. (Kids Say): Pray to the King. (*Kingdom Quest*)

(Parents Say): God is powerful. (Kids Say): He rescues us. (*Kids Church*)

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Participated in the game show, "Guess What Happened Next...", to review the lessons from the God is our King series.
- Played Bible Trivia as further review of lessons from the fall season.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Played the "Guess What Happens Next" game to review the lessons from the God is Powerful series.
- Made a Froot Loop cross craft as a reminder that God is powerful—he rescues us.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Page through an early reading Bible from King David forward. Invite your child to choose the Bible event to be read. Perhaps it will be a lesson your child remembers.

JESUS LINK:

- We can pray to God the King, because his Son, Jesus, died for us. (*Kingdom Quest*)
- God is so powerful that he sent his own Son, Jesus, so we could be forgiven. (*Kids Church*)

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How does God our King help us?
- When we have a problem, how can we turn to God our King?
- How does God rescue us?

PRAYER POWER:

Bring a prayer request to God the King, asking him for something you need or want. Thank him for using his power to rescue us.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Take turns designating the children in your family as king or queen for the day. When it is one child's turn to be the king or queen, he or she gets to: be the first to do things, decide what television shows to watch, have the biggest piece of cake or the last cookie, and make simple decisions, such as what to eat for dessert. On that day, pray with your child to always ask for God's help in making wise decisions.
