*Craft Zone:*

- a blank sheet of paper for each child
- crayons, markers, etc. to decorate paper
- tape
- stickers\* (Avery 5160) that read "Dance, shout, sing to the King"

*Play Zone:*

- no supplies

*Quiet Reading Zone*

- basket of books, include any stories you have about King David

*Music Zone:*

- combine with Drama Zone to create a parade; Music: *The Spirit of the Lord*, by Doug Larsen, from the CD titled, *Jesus Just Hold Me* (order through Doug Larsen Ministries, 206 East Ciro, Truman, MN 56088) or use your own choice of music.

*Craft Zone:*

- white or yellow, 3 or 4 inch, strips of paper, cut on one side in a zigzag pattern for a crown
- crayons, markers
- stickers\* (Avery 5160) that read, “Use your mind to serve the King.”
- tape or stapler

*Play Zone:*

- six varied objects

- puppets to act out the story of King Jehoshaphat from today’s Bible event; one child can play King Jehoshaphat, others can be singers, dancers and the army

*Craft Zone:*

- two *paper* plates per child
- stapler or glue
- several beans per child
- crayons and markers

- two pre-made stickers\* (Avery 5160 labels) for each child; one should say “God is our King” and the other should say “God will help us win”

*Play Zone:*

- masking tape to mark a start and a finish line on the floor

*Quiet Reading Zone:*

- basket of books, include any with the story of King Jehoshaphat

*Music Zone:*

## **Lesson 20**

*Welcome Zone:*

- blocks, toys, puzzles, paper, crayons

*Opening Worship:*

- cross, candles, Bible, offering plate
- stage should be very messy – filled with crumpled papers, etc.; have a few idols –statues or dolls covered in aluminum foil lying around; have a Bible or a scroll hidden under some trash in the corner
- Josiah costume (should include a crown & clothing that are too big for the child)

*Action Zones:*

*Snack Zone:*

- tortillas, spread with butter and cinnamon sugar
- *Optional:* use a fruit roll-up
- red string licorice

*Drama Zone:*

- seats, Bibles or hymnals, and an altar to create a church for the children to practice going to church and praying

*Felt Zone:*

- felt board and materials to show the story of King Josiah from today's Bible event (For example, use Lesson #84, "Good King Josiah," from *Betty Lukens Through the Bible in Felt*--order from [www.bettylukens.com](http://www.bettylukens.com))

*Puppet Zone:*

- puppets to act out the story of King Josiah from today's Bible event, or simply have them use the puppets to practice going to church and reading the Bible

*Craft Zone:*

- half sheets of blank paper folded in half to make a book of God's word
- crayons or markers to decorate the books
- two stickers\* (Avery 5160) for each child; one should say, "Hear the word of the Lord" and go on the front of the book; the other should say, "God is our King – God's word Rules" and go on the inside of the book

*Quiet Reading Zone:*

- basket of books, include any stories about King Josiah, or about the Bible, God's word

*Play Zone:*

- masking tape (enough to create 20-30-foot long strips, for marking floor into squares for the "garbage game")
- newspaper (for the kids to crumple into balls)
- large trash can

*Music Zone:*

- sing the song, *The B-I-B-L-E*, or other music of your choice promoting the Bible.

*Coloring Zone:*

- crayons and markers
