This Week's Lesson:

God uses Esther to save the Jews.

Take Home Point:

God is powerful – God's power saves.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Heard a big book story about Esther.
- Played tug-of-war as a reminder that, with God on our side, we have God's power to save us.
- Made a gift treat and gave it to a friend to celebrate God's love.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Watched a video about Esther and how God used her to save the Jews.
- Made and ate pretzel scepters in the snack zone.
- Made gift butterflies to share with friends.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

God uses Esther to save the Jews, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Esther.

JESUS LINK:

God saves us through Jesus.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What bad thing was going to happen to the Jews?
- How did God save them?
- How does God save us?

PRAYER POWER:

Have family members tell Jesus about some sins they have done. Thank him for dying on the cross to save you from those sins.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Bake some cookies together, or buy some special cookies from the store. Put several in a bag and attach a note to them that says, "Celebrate! Jesus died for YOU!" Share them with a neighbor or friend. As you eat some of the leftover cookies, remind your child that this is a celebration, because **"God is powerful—God's power saves!"**
