- Recreated the First Thanksgiving in the Drama Zone.
- Made "Thank You, God" magnets.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

The First Thanksgiving from a children's book, and read the Bible verse Psalm 136:1.

JESUS LINK: Thank you, Jesus, for dying for my sins..

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Why were the pilgrims thankful?
- What are you thankful for?
- How can you show God you are thankful?

PRAYER POWER:

Make a habit of adding prayers of thanksgiving to your mealtime or bedtime prayers.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Take your child grocery shopping with you. Allow him/her to pick out a few pantry items to deliver to a local food shelf or food drive. Explain that God blesses us with good things and we want to pass that blessing on to others.
