This Week's Lesson:

Josiah hears God's word.

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): God is our King.

(Kids Say): God's word rules.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Used a puzzle to learn the story of King Josiah hearing God's word.
- Made a scroll picture.
- Played "Follow the Leader" to remind us to follow God's word.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Participated in an interactive drama about King Josiah hearing God's word.
- Created a book of God's word as a reminder of the take home point.
- Played the "garbage game" as a reminder of King Josiah cleaning up the temple.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Josiah Hears God's Word from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from 2 Chronicles 34:14-33.

JESUS LINK:

God's Word tells us about Jesus.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What did Josiah do when he learned about God's Word?
- Why is God's Word important?
- When can we hear God's word?

PRAYER POWER:

Say a prayer thanking God for his word. Ask God to help you learn his word more each day.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

- 1) Make a scroll snack.
- 2) Spread butter on a six-inch tortilla.
- 3) Sprinkle cinnamon and sugar over the tortilla.
- 4) Roll the tortilla up from both ends, so that it meets in the middle.
- 5) Tie a red licorice lace around the center of the scroll.
- 6) Eat! As you enjoy the snack, remind your child that the Bible is God's word. It teaches us that God loves us, and how we can love him.
