DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Interviewed "Saul" who told us about meeting Jesus.
- Made an invitation to bring kids to church.
- Had a horse-race relay that ended with us shouting, "Share Jesus."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about Saul, when he believed in Jesus and how he shared the good news in Acts 26: 1-23 and chapter 9:1-20.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus died so that all who believe can be in his family.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How was Saul changed?
- What is the good news we should share?
- To whom can you tell Jesus' story?

PRAYER POWER:

Pray for someone who is not a believer. Ask Jesus to help you share his story with that person.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Invite a friend to your house and play "Penny Evangelism" with that friend. Toss a penny onto the craft sheet and retell that part of Jesus' story. After playing the game a few times, watch a Christian video together and then invite your friend to Kingdom Quest or Kids Church.
