Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): The Holy Spirit helps us believe.

(Kids Say): Believe in Jesus.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN

- Made a cross out of crackers.
- Played a water relay as a reminder that baptism shows we are a part of his family.

- Practiced baptizing our Teddy Grahams.
- Made a banner saying, "I am God's child."
- Worked with the felt board to show the story.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read or summarize the Bible event about the 3,000 who are baptized in Acts 2:14-41.

JESUS LINK:

The Holy Spirit shows us Jesus is Lord.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What wonderful thing happened in the Bible event?
- What does Jesus' Spirit help us to believe?
- What does Jesus tell us in baptism?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank Jesus that because he died on the cross. All who believe in him can be in his family. Thank him that for the gift of baptism, which means that God has given us his Spirit and we belong to him.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Pour out a bag of M&Ms or other favorite treat on the table. Help your child count the candies. As you eat them, remind your child that on Pentecost about 3,000 people believed in Jesus and were baptized. They were brought into God's family and given the gift of the Spirit. That is many more people than the number of candies on the table. Even so, Jesus cares especially you. He wants your child to believe in Jesus and receive the forgiveness he offers. He wants you and your child to be in his family.
