DRIVE TIME HOME

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Worked with the Little Disciple Picture to learn how to be a disciple.
- Ate little bread disciples that looked like Gingerbread men.
- Played Concentration with pieces from the Little Disciple Picture.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about what disciples do in Acts 2: 42-47

JESUS LINK:

Jesus lives in me. I have his love and his power to be a disciple.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What does it mean to be Jesus' disciple? Why do we want to be Jesus' disciple?
- How did the new believers live as disciples?
- How can we live as Jesus' disciples?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank Jesus for living in you and ask him to give you the power to live as his disciple.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Jesus loves you and died for the forgiveness of your sins so you can be a member of his family. Being a disciple means loving him back. Think of one way your family can give Jesus a service of love and carry it out.

Suggestions: Visit a church member who lives in a nursing home, pick up trash on church grounds or buy a new praise CD. Listen and dance to the CD or make a commitment to read a Bible story together as a family each evening.
