DRIVE TIME HOME

**PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN

- Participated in an imagination station dramatization of the jailer's conversion.
- Ate a cream-filled pastry to review God wanting to fill us with joy.
- Played a game, "Jail Break," and discussed Paul not leaving the jail but staying to teach the jailer about Jesus.

DRIVE TIME HOME

**PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.**

- Made paper chains that show that Jesus set us free.
- Watched a video of Paul and Silas in Jail.
- Taught Bubba that when we believe in God, we are part of God's family and are filled with joy.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

A Jailer and His Family Believe, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Acts 16:22-36.

JESUS LINK:

Believing in Jesus brings joy.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did God use Paul to bring the jailer to faith?
- How did believing in Jesus change the jailer?
- How does faith in Jesus change our hearts?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank Jesus for dying on the cross for you, bringing you to faith and filling your heart with his joy. Ask Jesus to help you share his joy with others.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Celebrate the joy you have in Jesus. Put on some praise music and have a dance. Try dancing with ribbons, scarves, a balloon, or streamers. Keep the rhythm by tapping spoons together or use a pot for a drum. What other items can you use with your dance to help you express your joy in Jesus?
