Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): Jesus is our friend.

(Kids Say): Bring Jesus home.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Watched a drama of the story of Zacchaeus.
- Played a ping-pong ball game as a reminder to bring Jesus home.
- Made a snack of gorp.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Watched a video about Zacchaeus climbing a tree to see Jesus.
- Made a house of graham crackers and frosting.
- Played with the dollhouse and pretended to take Jesus home.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Jesus Goes Home with Zacchaeus, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Luke 19:1-10.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus is a friend to everyone.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did Jesus show Zacchaeus he was his friend?
- How does Jesus show us he is our friend?
- How can we bring Jesus home with us?

PRAYER POWER:

Ask Jesus to be in your home and in the hearts of your family every day.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Set up a family altar. Place a children's Bible, adult Bible, picture of Jesus, candles and other faith objects on a coffee table, top of a book shelf, or other focal point. Make it a priority to gather around your family altar nightly for a devotional and prayer time. There are many wonderful resources for family devotions at local Christian bookstores.
