This Week's Lesson:

The Woman at the Well

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): Jesus is everyone's friend.

(Kids Say): Love everyone.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Acted out the Bible event of the woman at the well.
- Played a song game "Jesus at the Well."
- Made and ate bread and jelly hearts.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Learned that Jesus loves everyone, even those who are "looked down" on.
- Heard a monologue by the Samaritan woman.
- Our chips and dips reminded us of the woman at the well getting "living water."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

The Woman at the Well, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from John 4:4-28.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus does not think as the world does: he loves everyone.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did the people treat the Samaritan woman? Why
- How did Jesus treat the Samaritan woman? Why?
- Jesus loves everyone, including us. How can we share Jesus' love with other people?

PRAYER POWER:

Write a list of people your family can share Jesus' love with. Each night read the list to your child and pray for those people and chances to show them Jesus love.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Pick someone who is lonely—a neighbor, someone in a nursing home, a shut-in at your church (call the church office for the name of a shut-in)—and make a special treat to take to that person. Have your child decorate a picture and write on it, "Jesus loves you and so do we." Deliver the picture and treat.
