This Week's Lesson:

Woman Perfumes Jesus' Feet

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say) Jesus forgives us.

(Kids Say) We love Jesus.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Experience the story of a woman perfuming Jesus' feet through an audience participation story, focusing on smell.
- Discover ways to demonstrate our love for Jesus by playing a game, "Washing Feet."
- Make and eat "feet" for snack and talk about ways to show love to other people.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Heard the story of Mary washing Jesus' feet, perfuming them and drying them with her hair.
- Pretended to retell the story with our own washcloths, water and perfume.
- Traced our feet and decorated them.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

"A Woman Perfumes Jesus' Feet," from an early reader or read Luke 7:36-50.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus loves us—he died for our sins.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Why did the woman in the Bible event put perfume on Jesus' feet?
- Why do you love Jesus?
- How can you show Jesus you love him?

PRAYER POWER:

Tell Jesus you love him in a prayer. Thank him for showing you his love by dying on the cross and coming alive again so you can be forgiven.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Using markers, draw hearts on facial tissues and dab perfume, cinnamon, or some other sweet smelling scents onto them. Hide the tissues around your home. Whenever you find one you will be reminded that Jesus loves you, and you live him.
