Take Home Point:

(Parents Say) Jesus helps me -

(Kids Say) Say "No!" to Sin.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Listened to a storyteller share the story of Jesus being tempted in the desert.
- Made and ate "Bread and Cereal Bibles" and learned that studying God's Word can help us resist temptation.
- Played a game "Rocks of Temptations" and learned that Jesus helps us avoid temptation and forgives us when we sin.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Listened to "The Traveler" tell the story of Jesus' temptation.
- Created a dessert snack of bread and cinnamon sugar.
- Painted rocks to take home. They will remind me, **Jesus helps me say "no" to sin.*

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

The Temptation of Jesus in an early reading Bible or read and summarize the event from Matthew 4:1-11.

JESUS LINK: Jesus is the Victor over sin. Because I trust in him, I can have victory, too.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did Satan tempt Jesus and how did Jesus resist?
- How does Satan tempt us and how can we get help to resist temptation?
- What does Jesus do when we give in to temptation and sin?

PRAYER POWER:

Tell Jesus a sin you are tempted to do and ask him to help you not sin.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Go on a rock hunt around your neighborhood. Arrange the rocks in a box and add the words. "Resist the Devil and he will flee from you," to the box.
