## **This Week's Lesson:**

The Boy Jesus at the Temple

## **Take Home Point:**

(Parents Say) Jesus is God's Son.

(Kids Say) I want to learn about Jesus.

### **DRIVE TIME HOME**

#### **PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.**

- Dramatized the story of the boy Jesus in the temple.
- Ate trail mix while reviewing the Bible event.
- Played a game "Where's Jesus?" and talked about ways we can find out more about Jesus.

### **DRIVE TIME HOME**

#### **PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KIDS CHURCH.**

- Heard an echo pantomime to retell the Bible event.
- Made eyes out of vanilla wafers, marshmallows and chocolate chips or raisins.
- Used binoculars to "look for Jesus."

### **FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse**

The Boy Jesus at the Temple from an early reading Bible or read and summarize the event from Luke 2:41-52.

**JESUS LINK:** Learning about God's word, the Bible, helps us learn about Jesus.

### **TALK ABOUT IT:**

- Why was Jesus in the temple?
- Why do we want to learn more about Jesus?
- How can we learn about Jesus?

### **PRAYER POWER:**

Ask Jesus to help you learn more about him.

### **FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:**

If you are not doing family devotions in the evening, now is a good time to start. Light a couple candles, turn down the lights and read a Bible story about Jesus, sing a favorite Jesus song and say a prayer. You can also help your child learn more about Jesus by talking about Jesus during the day, watching Jesus videos, playing Jesus music on your stereo, and of course, attending church and Kingdom Quest.
