DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Acted out Jesus' resurrection.
- Had a special Easter snack while reviewing the Bible event.
- Played a game, "Jesus Wrap," and experienced the joy of Jesus' resurrection.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Examined nine eggs for clues. With the clues our presenter told us about Jesus' resurrection.
- Made angels with Bugles, Ritz Crackers, and pretzels.
- Pretended we entered the empty tomb to find a surprise.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

The Resurrection, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Matthew 28:1-10.

JESUS LINK: There is power through Jesus' resurrection. He is alive!

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What happened in today's Bible event?
- Why did Jesus die and rise again?
- How can you share the good news with others?

PRAYER POWER:

Praise Jesus for dying on the cross and rising again so that you can be forgiven. Ask him to help you share that good news with others.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Have a simple Easter celebration party and invite other friends over, especially those who do not attend church. Have an Easter egg hunt, share a special snack, and cut paper into egg shapes and decorate them. End by reading a book or watching a video that shares the true meaning of Easter.
