This Week's Lesson:

Jesus is Baptized

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say) Jesus is God's Son.

(Kids Say) I love Jesus.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Watched a video of John the Baptist and reviewed the Bible event with a silly story.
- Learned that God is three persons but one God using an apple snack,
- Played a game, "Water Relay," to learn that baptism is God saying, "I love you. You are my child."

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Saw the video "*John the Baptist*" tell about Jesus' baptism.
- Used puppets to tell about Jesus' love.
- Made a picture of a dove.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Jesus is Baptized from an early reading Bible or read and summarize the event from Matthew 3:13-17.

JESUS LINK: I love Jesus because he first loved me.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Why was Jesus' baptism like a holy hug?
- What does God tell us when we are baptized?
- How can we show Jesus that we love him?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank Jesus for dying on the cross so that you can become a child of God. Ask him to help you show him that you love him.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Play "Snuggle Octopus." Sit on the floor in the middle of the room and wave your arms wildly like an octopus. When your child runs past you, try to catch him. When you catch your child, give him a big hug and kiss and tell him you love him and so does God. Play this game as long as interest allows. It's important to give your child a hug and tell him how much God loves him, too!
